Cllr Holmes reported that there has been a longstanding water leak on Springfield
Road which runs from a property onto the road and can be quite hazardous when
weather turns cold. Advised to report directly to Gloucestershire County Council
(GCC).

Clir Osborne reported that the kerbing outside Orchard Stores was a trip hazard and that the owner of the store had reported and complained to GCC but to date no response. Council to also report this issue to GCC.

Cllr Harris reported that she had recently completed a 2hr webinar on "Planning in Plain English".

This was found to be very informative and useful and recommended fellow councillors to complete the webinar if given the opportunity.

Following a question raised it was confirmed that work should continue on the Council's Neighbourhood Development Plan (NDP) despite Forest of Dean District Council's current Local Plan undergoing review. It was recognised that some adjustments may need to be made to the Council's NDP to mirror the finalised Local Plan.
