	grounds be made:
	1. Highway Safety
	The Council has significant concerns regarding the proposed access arrangements. The application indicates access via a <i>private road</i> used by
	residents living on Templeway West. This raises serious safety concerns
	due to the increased traffic movements, potential conflicts between existing
	residents and new vehicles, and the additional congestion likely to be
	generated. The Council considers the access arrangements to be unsuitable
	and unsafe for the scale of development proposed.
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2. Traffic and Parking

The Council considers that the proposed development does not provide sufficient on-site parking provision for the number of dwellings proposed. This shortfall will inevitably lead to vehicles parking on the highway, exacerbating existing congestion and creating further safety risks for road users and pedestrians.

3. Layout and Density of Buildings

The number of dwellings proposed appears excessive for the size of the site. The layout and density are considered over-intensive, resulting in a cramped form of development out of keeping with the character of the surrounding area.

4. Effect on Listed Buildings and Conservation Area The proposed development is located adjacent to the boundary of a designated Conservation Area. The Council is concerned that the scale and design of the scheme will have a detrimental impact on the setting and character of nearby listed buildings and on the wider Conservation Area.

	Cllr Harris met with a former District Councillor who owns land where an old mill was located which also included a dam. The body of water in question flows through Viney Hill and joins Plummers Brook, which can contribute to exacerbating flooding within the Lakeside area. It was suggested that reinstating the dam could help reduce the volume of water reaching Lydney. Cllr Harris will liaise with Gloucestershire County Council and Forest of Dean District Council Flood Officers to arrange, if possible, a site visit ahead of the multi-agency Flood Stakeholder Meeting scheduled for March 2026.
	It was noted that an update relating to Albert Street wall was received from the clerk, and in summary:
	Update 16 October 2025 Extensive clearance of vegetation is planned for 3-6 November. Most vegetation above the wall (including several trees) will need to be removed to ensure the future stability of the bank. This work was previously planned for early September but was postponed due to resource pressures. Vegetation clearance will be followed by a topography survey, which provides a very clear picture of the local physics. This information is essential to ensuring the wall can be removed safely. The overhead BT cable was successfully diverted on 13 August. It is expected to remove the wall and regrade the land in Summer 2026.
	However, following a major health and safety incident on Tuesday 4 th November 2025 work has now been suspended.
